WORSHIP

As of June 15, 2021, there are no COVID capacity limits in the sanctuary. As a result, burlpres will no longer request registration or check-ins prior to attending worship. All are welcome.

9:00 a.m. Indoor Classic worship service:

We will continue to host our Classic in-person 9:00 a.m. service in our Sanctuary where all are welcome and simultaneously livestream to our [burlpres YouTube channel](#). The Family Room will be open adjacent to the sanctuary.

At 11:00 a.m. our Outdoor Modern service is offered in our plaza and also available on our [burlpres YouTube channel](#). Please be sure to bring weather-appropriate clothing, hats and water bottles.

WORSHIP (CONT.)

Masking in worship:

burlpres will continue to follow CDC, state and county health guidelines.

- **Indoor Worship:** All people, regardless of vaccination status, will need to wear masks
- **Outdoor Worship:** Masks are optional for people who are vaccinated. People who are not vaccinated should continue wearing masks.

Masks are required for all adults and youth working with Kids and Students as a volunteer or staff member, even if they are vaccinated.

Singing:

Indoor: We can sing with masks on.

Outdoor: We can sing with no masks once again.

Communion:

We will continue to provide individual communion portion (bread and cup) with a gluten-free option available.

BURLPRES KIDS

burlpres KIDS, in-person Sunday activities for children three years to those entering 5th grade are available. There will be a supervised Kids time that runs concurrent with the family service in the plaza. As always, children and families will continue to be welcomed into any service at any time.

Because our children are not yet vaccinated, we have modified our program to comply with burlpres' COVID protocols to keep our whole community safe. Here's what you need to know:

- Everyone must wear masks while inside the church, even if they're vaccinated.
- Children participating in our activity time will social distance at least three feet apart as much as possible.
- For children younger than three years old, parents are required to maintain supervision.



FAL PLANNING FOR MINISTRY EVENTS

As of June 15, 2021, burlpres has opened for limited events and services on campus.

There are no COVID capacity limits on campus or in the sanctuary. If you would like to plan in-person events, with Zoom capability, you may sign-up for one of the portable flat screen TVs that connects with computers. Technology training will be provided. Many rooms have Wi-Fi and you can connect a laptop with the TV to run Zoom or other media in any room for all events.

OFFICE HOURS

burlpres staff and clergy will be working in the office and for a few positions, from home depending on family needs over the summer. Staff will be in the office Monday - Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. The office will be open for pre-arranged appointments and meetings. As always, staff can be reached by email or phone call.

Current CAI-OSHA guidelines adapted for burlpres offices include:

- Employees and visitors who are fully vaccinated must wear face coverings while indoors and in mixed company with employees/campus visitors who are not fully vaccinated.
- Employees have the option to remove masks if they are alone behind closed doors.
- **Masks are welcome to be worn everywhere on the burlpres campus no matter a person's vaccination status.**

BURLPRES PRESCHOOL

Preschool Summer Camp will be held on campus through August and the Fall Program resumes in September. Only Preschool staff and children may be in the Children's Ministry Center (CMC) during summer school hours (Monday through Friday) from 9 am – 12 pm. The days and hours for school will be posted on CMC doors. The CMC doors will remain locked during those times in order to continue to follow the Covid-19 county and state health mandates for preschools.
