Thank you for your interest in taking part in the 2023 Mexico Mission Trip. Please read this Packet carefully. Note: there are some changes from previous years.

Purpose: This mission trip is an intergenerational trip, consisting of youth from ninth grade and up. The trip involves three key components – building houses in a depressed area of Tijuana, building relationships with one another, and growing in our faith and trust in God.

Dates: The dates of the trip are all inclusive and all travelers are expected to remain with the group throughout the trip.

Age Requirement and Parent Participation: Students going into ninth grade and up may attend; however, due to the nature of the trip, students under the age of 18 must have a parent attend with them or another approved, responsible adult.

Passports Required: All participants must have a valid passport. No exceptions. It can take two months or more to obtain a passport. Please don't wait! **Must provide photocopy.**

Covid Vaccination Information: All trip participants must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19. *Must provide a photocopy.* All participants will be required to adhere to all applicable health guidelines during the trip.

REQUIREMENTS

Participants are expected to attend the mandatory Gearing Up Gatherings on May 7th and July 16th. The purpose of the Gearing Up Gatherings is not only to provide information about this trip, but also to build a community, which is very important to working in Mexico. All participants are also required to help with *Jazz in the Afternoon* on June 3, through donations and/or services. Please see "Dates to Remember" for a comprehensive list.

All adult participants may be expected to be fingerprinted, undergo a background check and complete a burlpres child safety training seminar pursuant to California AB 506 [2021]

Trip Cost: \$600* Includes building materials for the homes in Tijuana, food, water, transportation, and other required and necessary expenses, including adult fingerprinting and child safety training as required by California law. *Cost may be lowered due to the fund raiser.

Plus: Roundtrip Airline ticket We will be flying to San Diego and renting vehicles to drive across the border. You will need to purchase your ticket to the San Diego Airport. We encourage you to use the flights we will announce. However, you may use alternative modes of travel if you arrive no later than 10:30 AM on Sunday, July 23, and plan to return to the Bay Area from San Diego Airport Friday, July 28 on flights departing no earlier than 6:00 PM. Please note: All minors need to travel with a parent or other guardian participating in the work trip.

Applications Due: Friday April 28

Turn in completed applications and \$100 deposit to Sonu at the church office. A late fee of \$75 will be added on to any application received after the due date. Jazz in the Afternoon Fundraiser: Saturday, June 3, 2 PM-5 PM All Mexico travelers are required to participate in this event — working as a team to host it, or alternatively by making a donation to help defray costs.
